



Conception of competition

Project “BALTIC TROPHY”, first organized in 2009 among Baltic countries, had incredible success and positive feedback from all participated shooters.

This year, organizers decided to repeat "Baltic Trophy, adding a fourth country - Poland.

This project was created to strengthen cooperation at the level of shooting clubs of the Baltic countries, as well as for promotion of all types of Sporting in the Baltic countries: Sporting, Compak Sporting and English Sporting.

1. Aims and goals of the competitions.

- 1.1. To popularize and promote all Sporting shooting disciplines in Baltic countries: Sporting, Compak Sporting and English Sporting.
- 1.2. To consolidate co-operation of shooting clubs of Baltic countries.

2. Organizers and participants.

2.1. Organizers of the competitions of “BALTIC TROPHY 2010” are:

- Latvia: Shooting range in Viesaki and Latvian Sporting Federation.
- Lithuania: Club “Sporting LT” and Lithuanian Hunt Shooting Federation;
- Estonia: Elva Hunt Shooting Club (Elva shooting range);
- Poland.

The organizing body of each separate stage before final stage and final stage may be national shooting federation or independent shooting club. Organizing body has to be capable to organize and carry out the competition on the level corresponding to standards for international competitions from technical and organizational point of view. Mandatory condition is to secure, that in carrying out of competition there must be followed the international rules of FITASC (Sporting, Compak Sporting) and CPSA (English Sporting), also international traditions and ethics of such events.

2.2. Participants may be members of national shooting federations and shooters from other countries. There are no geographical restrictions for participants.

3. Description of the competitions.

Considering that the calendars of shooting events of national shooting federations and FITASC are pretty tight, it will be reasonable to consider the option to attach the stages of “BALTIC TROPHY” to national Championships or Cups. It enables to promote the level of competition from national level to international level and gather bigger number of participants.

3.1. Stages

In 2010 the competitions of "BALTIC TROPHY" will be held in four (4) stages – three (3) pre-stages and Final Stage:

3.1.2. First Stage. Latvia, Shooting range in Viesaki (Madonas district).

Discipline: Sporting;

Competition will be held in accordance to the FITASC international rules for Sporting.

3.1.1. Second Stage. Lithuania, Zemsode (Klaipeda district).

Discipline: Compak Sporting;

Combined with Lithuanian Open Championships;

Competition will be held in accordance to the FITASC international rules for Compak Sporting.

3.1.3. Final Stage. Poland

Discipline: Compak Sporting;

Competition will be held in accordance to the FITASC international rules for Compak Sporting

Date of Competition: 2-3 of October 2010

Targets: 200

Competition Groups: Based on results of pre-stages all participants will be divided into four (4) separate competition groups no matter of age or gender: Group «A» - shooters with the most high scores, the rest of the shooters will be divided into groups «B», «C» and «D» according to results in decreasing order. If the shooter participates in two or three preliminary stages, then for the final ranking takes into account only one, but the best result.

In case of equal result, shoot-off will be held with the "**First Zero Eliminary**" for each

group.

Entry fee: 75,- EUR for all competition groups.

Organizer: Poland

Deadline for applying: 29 of September 2010

Max. number of participants is 144 shooters!

Participants of the Final Stage: in order to participate in the Final Stage, the shooter must participate in at least one pre-stages, whether in Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia or Poland.

Those shooters, who have not participated in at least one pre-stage, will be allowed to enter the competition only, if there is vacancy in the Final Stage. But those shooters can compete only in group «A» and they have not the option to compete in Super Final.

3.2. Rating of shooters between pre-stages and the Final Stage and division into competition groups

- The best score of each stage (not depending on competition group) is counted as 100%;
- The scores of the rest of the shooters, participated in corresponding stage, will be evaluated in percents in relation with the best score and percents will be calculated max. two spaces after decimal point;
- In drawing the interim rating list before the Final Stage, there will be counted the best score achieved in pre-stages (in %);
- All shooters, who have participated in pre-stages, will be divided into four (4) groups (all equal by the total number of the shooters) based on drawn interim rating list.

3.3. Ascertainment of the winners of the Final Stage

The winner and final ranking of other shooters of each separate group will be ascertained based on the best score of the Final Stage. Scores achieved in pre-stages will not be taken into account.

3.4. Super Final

- The Super Final will be held in accordance to the FITASC international rules for Compak Sporting. All targets in Super Final will be flash targets in order to offer better look from the point of viewers.
- For ascertainment the Super Final participants, there will be drawn Final Rating List in which the scores, achieved by the shooter at the Final Stage, will be added to the scores in the interim rating list;
- In Super Final will be six (6) shooters who are top 6 shooters in Final Rating List;
- Final places of the six (6) best shooters of the “BALTIC TROPHY 2010” will be cleared based only on the results of the Super Final and all other scores will not be taken into account. In case of equal Super Final scores of the shooters, there will be shoot-off by principle “until FIRST MISS” until the final places of all six (6) shooters are clear.

3.5. Awarding

3.5.1. In pre-stages will be awarded three best shooters of each competition group. Those shooters will be awarded with diplomas and medals of corresponding pre-stage competition. If there will be substantial sponsor support to organizer, it may decide additional awards, such as memento etc.

3.5.2. In Final Stage will be awarded three best shooters of each group. Those shooters will be awarded with diplomas, medals and prizes from the prize fund of the “BALTIC TROPHY 2010”.

3.5.3. The winner of Super Final will be awarded with GP; three best shooters of the Super Final will be awarded with gold, silver and bronze medal and prizes, the last three with memento medals of “BALTIC TROPHY 2010” and prizes.
